At the top of Sulphur Mountain, spectacular views await from the 360-degree observation deck. Next, make your way to visit the Columbia Icefield, hop on an Ice Explorer ride on the Athabasca Glacier, then a stop at the award-winning Glacier Skywalk experiencing a glass-floored observation platform 918 ft over spectacular glacier-formed valleys and rushing waterfalls. Then, get onboard your spectacular Rocky Mountaineer rail journey as you travel through Kamloops to Vancouver. The real cherry on top is a 7-night Alaska Inside Passage cruise on Royal Caribbean's Serenade of the Seas ship! You'll have the chance to make pit-stops in Ketchikan, Juneau, Skagway & Tracy Arm before making your way back to Vacnouver for your flight home.



## **Itinerary**

Day 1

#### Australia X Calgary

Your adventure starts today with your flight to Canada. Depart downtown Calgary and travel west through the rolling foothills with the Canadian Rocky Mountains in the horizon. Upon arrival into Banff you will visit such points as Bow Falls, Surprise Corner, and the Hoodoo rock formations, before a stop at the Banff Gondola. At the top of Sulphur Mountain spectacular views await from the 360 degree observation deck. After the tour your Driver/Guide will take you to your hotel.

Accommodation: Banff Inns Hotel or similar, Banff

Meals included: inflight only

#### Day 2

#### Banff 🖨 Jasper

Travel by coach today via one of the most scenic highways in North America - the Icefields Parkway. Visit the Columbia Icefield that covers an area of nearly 125 sq mi (325 sq km) and reaches a depth of 1050 ft (320 m). Time allows for an Ice Explorer ride (included) on the Athabasca Glacier, then a stop at the award-winning Glacier Skywalk (included) experiencing a glass-floored observation platform 918 ft (280 m) over spectacular glacier-formed valleys and rushing waterfalls. Photo stops along the Parkway will be made at Lake Louise, Bow Lake, the Crowfoot Glacier and the Athabasca Falls. This highway is renowned for sightings of bears, elk, moose & mountain sheep, so keep your camera handy. Please note: mountain lakes in this region will be frozen through to mid-June.

Accommodation: Lobstick Lodge or similar, Jasper

Meals included: breakfast and lunch

## Day 3

#### **Rocky Mountaineer (Jasper to Kamloops)**

All aboard Rocky Mountaineer for a scenic rail journey to Kamloops in the interior of British Columbia. Leaving Jasper National Park, travel the 'Yellowhead' route past the sprawling grandeur of Mount Robson 'the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies and follow the mighty Thompson River, the route of early fur traders, before arriving in Kamloops.

Accommodation: Thompsons Hotel or similar, Kamloops

Meals included: breakfast and lunch



## Day 4

#### Rocky Mountaineer (Kamloops to Vancouver)

Leaving Kamloops, follow the Thompson River through Ashcroft, one of Canada's driest towns, with an average rainfall of just 18 centimetres. Pass through Rainbow Canyon, named for its cliffs striped with pinks, greens and greys creating a stunning rainbow effect. Continue on to the Fraser Canyon, where at Hell's Gate watch water torrent past the canyon walls at its narrowest point. The last leg of the journey takes you through the fertile farming region of the Fraser Valley to arrive in the Pacific port of Vancouver late afternoon.

Accommodation: Rosedale Hotel or similar, Vancouver

Meals included: breakfast and lunch

#### Day 5

#### Vancouver

Today is a free day to explore Vancouver at leisure. Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia, is among Canada's densest, most ethnically diverse cities. A popular filming location, it's surrounded by mountains, and also has thriving art, theatre and music scenes. Vancouver Art Gallery is known for its works by regional artists, while the Museum of Anthropology houses preeminent First Nations collections.

Accommodation: Rosedale Hotel or similar, Vancouver

Meals included: breakfast

## Alaska Inside Passage Cruise (Vancouver boarding)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Vancouver cruise terminal to check in for your Alaska Inside passage cruise on the Serenade of the Seas. The ship will depart at approximately 6pm.

Accommodation: Serenade of the Seas ship in an Inside Cabin<sup>^</sup> on twinshare basis with private bathroom facilities
