Day 4

Queenstown

- Take it easy riding the Skyline Gondola, 450m above Queenstown and Lake Wakatipu.
- What's better than an eagle eye view over the snow-capped mountains? A helicopter flight that lands you on one. Touch the snow and feel the crisp air against your cheek before lifting back above the mountains and returning to Queenstown.

Sometimes travel is as much about the food as it is the sights. Tonight is one such evening. Dine on locally sourced produce at The Grille by Eichardts.
